Vulnerable Adult Protective Investigative Teams (VAPIT) are appointed by the local District Attorney General and comprised of representatives from law enforcement and Adult Protective Services (APS). These teams are tasked with investigating suspected instances of abuse, neglect, or exploitation of vulnerable adults.

**Child Investigative Protective Teams** 

Child Protective Investigative Teams (CPIT) are appointed by the local district attorney General and are comprised of representatives from law enforcement, Department of Children Services, the local Juvenile Court and may also include professionals from non-profit organizations. These teams are tasked with investigating suspected instances of child sexual abuse.
