


# Tennessee District Attorneys General Conference



## 2025 CPIT REPORT

Department of Children's Services (DCS) receives reports of suspected child sexual or physical abuse.



Reports are sent to the respective Child Protective Investigative Team (CPIT), comprised of specially trained law enforcement officers and local Juvenile Court and DCS representatives.

CPITs meet at least once a month to coordinate responses to and investigations of reports.

### 2025 by the Numbers

**24,408**

reports of suspected instances of abuse received by CPIT Teams.

**7,660**

reports determined to be substantiated cases of abuse after thorough review by CPIT teams.

**15,088**

community-based interventions coordinated by CPITs in response to substantiated reports.
